In continuation of our earlier disclosure dated December 31, 2023, made pursuant to Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations, we wish to inform that pursuant to an Order in adjudication for FY 2017-18, received by Dalmia Cement (Bharat) Limited ("DCBL"), wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, the Commercial State Tax Officer, Lalgudi, Ariyalur, Trichy, Tamil Nadu, has dropped the entire demand of tax & penalty, amounting to Rs. 62,37,57,008/- and Rs. 6,23,75,701/respectively, earlier confirmed by the State Tax Officer, Lalgudi Assessment Circle, Lalgudi, Ariyalur, Trichy, Tamil Nadu, based on submission of documents as per directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras (Madurai Bench) in WP(MD) No. 1644 of 2024.

The Order has been received on October 16, 2025 at 07:11 P.M.

The details of any change in the status and /or any development in relation to such proceedings;	Dalmia Cement (Bharat) Limited ("DCBL"), wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, had earlier received an Order pertaining to AY 2017-18 on December 30, 2023 from The Commercial Tax Officer, Lalgudi Assessment Circle, Lalgudi, Ariyalur, Trichy, Tamil Nadu, on various grounds under the CGST Act 2017. The said Order had confirmed the demand of: a) Tax: Rs. 62,37,57,008/-; and b) Penalty: Rs. 6,23,75,701/ DCBL had filed Writ Petitions before the Hon'ble High Court of Madras (Madurai Bench) and based on the directions of the Hon'ble Court, The Commercial Tax Officer has re-examined the matter based on our submissions and has passed order dated October 16, 2025, in DRC-07, and dropped the entire demand of tax and penalty as mentioned above. Accordingly, there will be no financial impact on DCBL.
