Dear Sir/Madam,

Pursuant to Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations, we wish to inform you that OCL India Limited now known as Dalmia Cement (Bharat) Limited ("DCBL"), wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, has received order under Section 73 of the Central Goods and Services Tax Act, 2017 on December 26, 2023, pertaining to Input Tax Credit ("ITC") mismatch, non-filing of GSTR-3B by the suppliers and interest liability on late reversal of ITC for the tax period from July, 2017 to March, 2018 amounting to tax liability of Rs. 15.63 Lakhs along with interest and penalty.

DCBL has a good case on merits to defend the matter before the Appellate Authorities and shall file an appeal against the said order before the Commissioner (Appeals) within prescribed timelines.

The details as required under Regulation 30 of the Listing Regulations read with SEBI circular dated SEBI/HO/CFD/CFD-PoD-1/P/CIR/2023/123 dated July 13, 2023 are provided in the Annexure hereto.
